The ABCs of Mining Exploration

Preparation of drilling sites

In order to begin and continue mining exploration, it is necessary to prepare the drilling sites and the roads to access them. The majority of the sites identified for exploration activities are in a raw state and are not accessible by land as is.

Like any exploration company, O3 Mining must therefore prepare the areas dedicated to drilling and determine the best access roads.

During this work, the company does not carry out massive deforestation operations. On a few occasions, it must carry out clearing work in order to create access roads and sites for the drills.



O3 Mining ensures that only accesses essential to its exploration activities are opened. The company also complies with all applicable regulations regarding the size of roads and developed sites. These practices are subject to ECOLOGO® UL 2723 certification, where an independent third party ensures that they meet high environmental standards.

Drill site preparation is an essential step in the exploration process and one that O3 Mining places great importance on.

Protection Measures

In order to minimize its impact on the environment during the preparation of drilling sites, O3 Mining put in place the following measures:

- Determine access routes and drilling sites with the objective of limiting the quantity and quality of deforestation to minimize the impact on forests.
- Protect shorelines beyond existing regulations.
- Seeding roads and drilling sites after the work is completed to accelerate the recovery of ecosystems.
- Plant trees where work is completed.
- Use existing roads and facilities where possible.
- Reuse cut wood to create protective mats under the drills.

Marban Drilling in 2022

In 2021, O3 Mining drilled approximately 60,000 metres at the Marban project. The results, which were very positive for the year, show that the exploration work is very promising and going well.

For the year 2022, we plan to drill approximately 30,000 additional metres. We are committed to continue to respect our host communities and to keep you informed of our projects and activities.
